

## Dimmick Park Swale Greening Phase I (Awarded 2020)

#### SUMMARY

Phase I of improving and greening the drainage swale addresses the stormwater channel on both sides of the new concrete staircase. This project transformed the existing rock drainage channel into a green swale that includes grading, excavation, stabilization check dam, sodding, perennial grasses and plugs, and native trees and shrubs.



# CHALLENGE

A grass swale at the southern end of Dimmick Park collects water and feeds it into an open asphalt channel within the park that directs the stormwater into a culvert before discharging into the Silver Creek. Because this channel was paved, water flowed rapidly and did not infiltrate — exacerbating downstream flooding. This project was the visible kick off of a large plan that will transform the entire stormwater channel into a green stream bed that will improve water quality and fish habitat, reduce flooding, and enhance the park's natural beauty.
